

Warrant Officer Candidate School Options

Option 1: All soldiers E1-E5 who have not completed WLC/PLDC will attend WOC at Ft. Rucker, AL for 6 weeks and 4 days

Phase 1 Resident - The course length for this phase is 2 weeks. Attendance at the Phase 1 (Resident) course is MANDATORY for all Soldiers in the grade of E-1 through E-4 and for E-5's that are not WLC/PLDC graduates. Student enrolled in Phase 1 (resident) class 06-012 should also be enrolled in Phase 2 class 06-012.

Phase 2 Resident – The course length for this phase is 4 weeks and 4 days. All candidates attend resident phase 2 training.

Option 2: All soldiers E5 and above who have completed WLC/PLDC have the option to attend WOC at Ft. Rucker, AL for 4 weeks and 4 days

Phase 1 DL – 90 hours DL will be completed nonresident. There is only one Phase 1 DL class scheduled, covering the entire training year. Once you have been enrolled in ATRRS for Course 911-09W (DL), you will access the training at <https://wocc.learn.army.mil> by logging in with your AKO user name and password

Phase2 Resident – The course length for this phase is 4 weeks and 4 days. All candidates attend resident phase 2 training.

Option 3: WOCS RC is for soldiers E5 and above who have completed WLC/PLDC have the option to attend WOC at the RTI (MD or PA)

Phase 1 DL – 90 hours DL completed at HS. There is only one Phase 1 DL class scheduled, covering the entire training year. Once you have been enrolled in ATRRS for Course 911-09W (DL), you will access the training at <https://wocc.learn.army.mil> by logging in with your AKO short name and password

Phase 2 – All candidates will attend five MUTA at the RTI (MD or PA)

Phase 3 – All candidates will attend two week annual training at consolidated locations
